Kindergarten Supply List

Unlike previous years, EACH student will need their OWN materials to keep AT SCHOOL. As such, the following supplies will NOT be shared. The quantities are flexible based on your child's needs. When possible, please label all materials with your child's name.

- Indoor Shoes: Rubber soled, sneakers, or slip on shoes (i.e. Crocs). Children will change from outdoor to indoor shoes when entering the classroom, helping keep the environment clean. (**No slippers, movie characters, cartoons, superheroes, or lights** as they can be distracting.)
